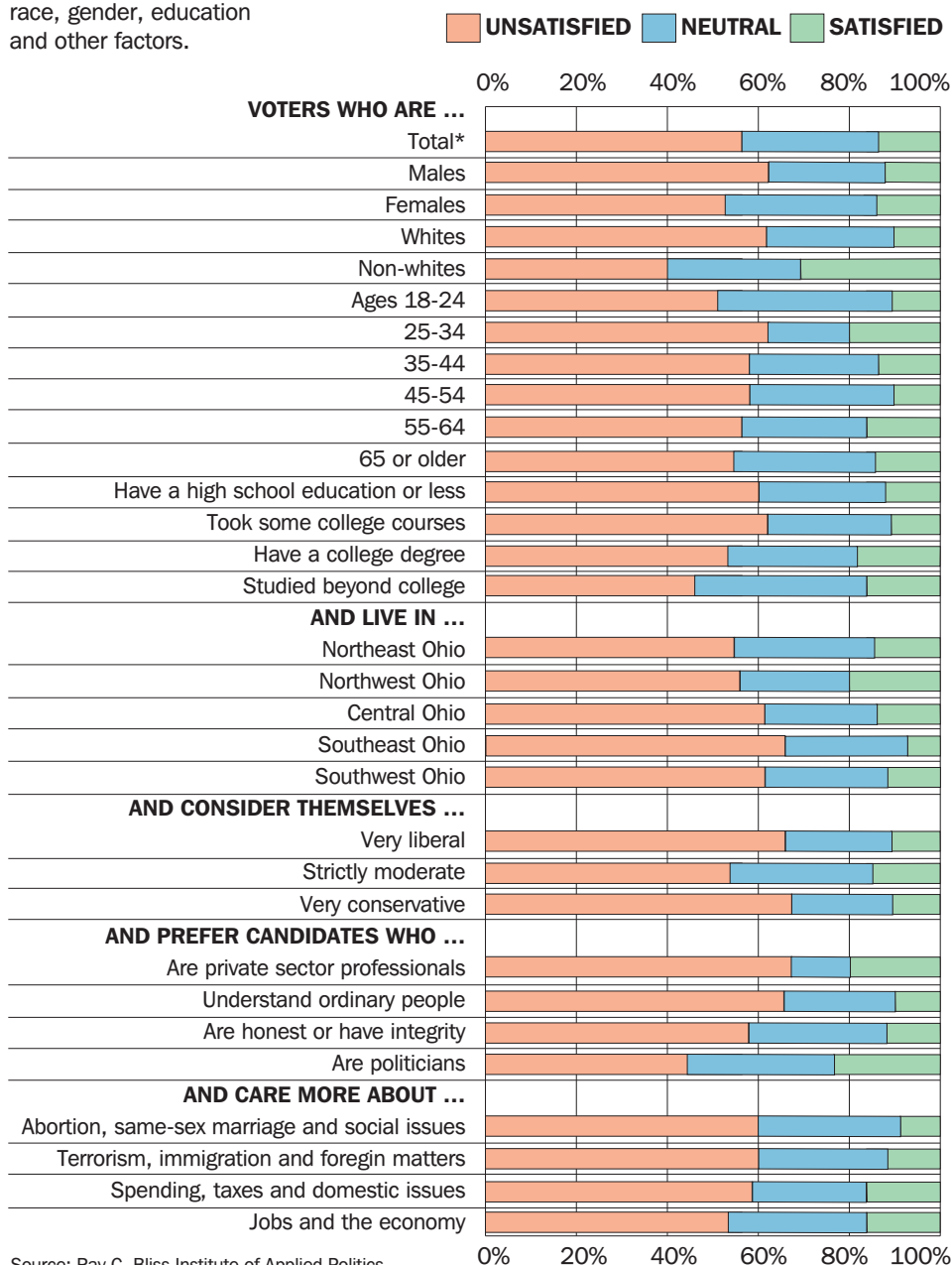


# Dissatisfaction unites voters

Minorities, the highly educated and voters who support career politicians are the least disgusted with American politics. A November 2015 poll shows disdain for candidates, campaigns and the presidential election is widespread. Some groups (like white, religious men from southern Ohio) hold extreme disdain. Here's how the disgust plays out by age, race, gender, education and other factors.
